*NOTES:

Hammered Dulcimer Players: Hit the E on one side of the treble bridge and push down on the other side. This will "twang" the E up to an F and back down.

Mountain Dulcimer Players: Pluck the E on the 2nd string 4th fret as indicated on the TAB. Then pull the string towards you to bend up to the F pitch.
